



EITA Elevator Fire Drill – 19 July 2016



On 19th July 2016, Eita Elevator (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd organized a Fire Drill Exercise. The objective of this drill is to practice the evacuation plan route from the building during fire or other emergencies. Timing for evacuation was taken during this drill to ensure that evacuation process occurred within a reasonable length of time. In addition, any problems regarding the emergency system or escape route were identified and appropriate action steps to be taken to rectify them.

The fire drill was assisted by our own staffs from Safety Department. They also /demonstrated on how to handle the fire extinguisher the proper way.



Step by Step of P.A.S.S

(P) Pull - The first step is to pull the pin (it usually has the inspection tag attached to it) that prevents the handle from being squeezed.

(A) Aim - The second step is to aim the spray nozzle, or if attached the hose nozzle, at the fire. Aim low at the base of the fire.

(S) Squeeze - The third step is to squeeze the handle to spray the contents. Remember a standard fire-extinguisher has less than 30 seconds of spray time.

(S) Sweep - The final step is to sweep back and forth as you spray the base of the fire.
